## What to do:

Register your interest by notifying the competition host (Chip) via email. You will need an email address to participate. Paper trail will be made available initially, but the intention is for you to participate using email and excel.

Think of a Team Name

Send your name and team name to: <u>chipj1803@gmail.com</u> or let your host (Chip) know via social media or in person. Your host (Chip) will confirm your registration.

Keep a close eye on Selection Lists each week

Email your Weekly Nominated Team by each Saturday morning, using the Team Nomination Template provided to you, once you have registered.

## Rules:

Any questions, queries, or feedback may be directed to your host, Chip

It is about the scoring of points each week, not each game (this is to take into fair account that one and two-day games play a part in this competition)

- refer to the Points Summary for details
- : highest score each week wins a weekly prize
- : weekly scores accumulate until end of regular season

three highest accumulated scores at the end of the regular season will be awarded a prize, and bragging rights

A Nominated Team shall consist of 11 GGCC players, a minimum of 2 from each senior grade

A captain and a wicket keeper shall be nominated for each team each week

A nominated captain's points scored shall double for that week

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A Nominated Team may change each week

A Nominated Team may only be valid for any given week, if submitted using the provided Team Nomination Template, and emailed to your host (Chip) by each Saturday morning of the relevant week (ie cut off time is noon on the day of the game)

Failure to meet any of the rules may result in no points being awarded for the relevant week, at the discretion of your host, Chip

Experimental changes to the rules of the inaugural GGCCFCC, effective immediately (5/1/15) (every effort will be made to notify everyone via multiple forms of media):

1. Your nominated Wicket Keeper each week must be a legitimate Wicket Keeper (actually expected to wear the gloves). If you fail to nominate a legitimate wicket keeper, your team will be deducted points to the value of your average player score within your team for that week.

2. A 12th Man may be chosen for your nominated team. This player can be from any of the senior teams, and will be included if a nominated player within your team does not play.

3. Bonus Points adjustment for run scoring:
30 runs = 30 bonus points
50 runs = 50 bonus points
100 runs = 100 bonus points
150 runs = 150 bonus points
....and so on....
