It's really pleasing that there's a great team culture around this year's Golden Grove Yellow U12s Division 3 cricket team. All the players are striving to contribute, supporting their mates, and working hard to develop their cricket skills. We've been focussing really hard to improve our skills; batting a bit more correctly, bowling more consistently and fielding more accurately. It's really great to see how much effort the boys are putting in and how much they enjoy their cricket.

**Round 1** saw us play against Brahma Lodge. With very accurate bowling and a tight field Brahma Lodge were restricted to 7/43. While it was a great team effort all-round, best figures were R. Short 2/8 and C. Edmunds 2/8. In reply, the Yellows scored freely to make 4/181. With a combination of classy shots and bludgeoning the ball to the boundary, top scorers were R. Toner 52, A. Bradshaw 36 and C. Gammon 27.

**Round 2** against Eastern Suburbs White saw the Grove Yellows bat first. With a good team effort most players contributed to reach 8/101 with A. Bradshaw top scoring on 29. In reply we had another good team effort in the field keeping Eastern Suburbs to 7/54 with best figures C. Edmunds 2/3 and C. Gammon 2/6.

**Round 3** against Ingle Farm was unfortunately declared a draw, due to match time scheduling.

**Round 4** was a friendly seeing GG Yellow play GG Gold. Gold won the toss and elected to bat and were kept to 4/40 off 20 overs with a smooth run out orchestrated by M. Zimmerman and wickets to H. Laird, C. Edmunds and R. Short. The Grove Yellows went on to make 5/98 with A. Bradshaw unbeaten on 23.

**Round 5** saw us travel to Oval 10 to play a time-shortened game against the Walkerville Pumas. Winning the toss we elected to bat. We batted with composure and maturity and hit some classy cricket shots along the ground to the boundary to make 2/168. Top scorers were H. Laird 29 not out and J. Field 22 not out. We then bowled and fielded well, with three catches and two run-outs, to dismiss Walkerville for 93 in the 27<sup>th</sup> over. Best bowling figures were J. Field with an impressive spell of 3/2 off 2.2.

**Round 6:** The final round of grading saw a top-of-the-table clash against Glenunga Rockets. Winning the toss and batting first, those batsmen who waited for the loose balls spent a good time at the crease. Eventually we were bowled out in the 27<sup>th</sup> over for 125 runs with top scorers being H. Laird 44, C. Atkinson 32 and C. Gammon 16. Some hard-hitting batting from Glenunga and excellent bowling and fielding from the Brumbies saw a very tight contest. The boys did well to push to the end and bowl Glenunga out for 128. A. Bradshaw had best figures with the ball taking 3/10 off 3.4.

It's been a very successful start to the Season from the u12's Yellow Brumbies who are enjoying their game, supporting each other and working hard to improve their cricket. The lads have shown great sportsmanship throughout, with a pleasing amount of support to each other in the field. They do the club, our sponsors and themselves proud- well done boys!
