SENIOR SELECTION POLICY 2018/19

Our commitment

Our Club supports an open and transparent process for the selection of teams. Selection will be based on clear criteria that are communicated to the player and/or playing group as required or requested.

The Selection Committee will comprise the following people

Damien Stamato

Club Coach and captains

Selection will be determined by the following criteria

- The A and B grade squad and floating squad (see "Process") shall be the foremost consideration.
- Players must be financial (as determined by the Committee based on individual circumstances).
- Conduct of the player during matches, training, Club functions and social media.
- Match day performance – both on and off the field.
- Training attendance, participation and attitude.
- Attendance at Club functions.

Process

- The Selection Committee will select 24-26 players that will make the nucleus of the 2 day squad. (the squad)
- The squad will consist of selected "A" grade players and "B" grade players who have been assessed as being capable of taking a spot in the A grade, should form or availability dictate.
- There will be a pool of players from the C and D grade who will act as the "floating squad" to fill in spots in the A and B grade where required. The players in this pool will be approached by the Selection Committee at the start of the season to confirm that they are willing to play 2 day cricket.
- Both squads will be reviewed at the mid point of the season.
- The Selection Committee will consult with the coach and captains in regards to the selection of the team.
- Selectors have been appointed by the Committee and will ultimately be responsible for selection decisions.

- Selection may be discussed by the members of the Selection Committee in person at training and matches, on the phone, via email or any other way they see fit.
- Teams will be announced in the Harper's Field clubrooms after Thursday night training.
- Teams will also be published on the Club web site and smart phone app.
- As requested, or as necessary, players will be provided with reasons for non-selection and areas to improve in order to be considered for selection.
- Selection criteria will be reiterated during the season so that players are clear about the how teams competing in the finals will be chosen.
- Concerns about team selection should be discussed with the Selection Committee in the first instance. A formal written complaint to the Club Committee should be made if these concerns cannot be resolved and the player believes s/he has not been treated in accordance with the Selection Policy.

What we ask you to do

Selection committee

- Ensure players are informed about and understand the selection criteria and processes.
- Make fair and unbiased decisions based on the selection criteria.

Players

- Make yourself familiar with the selection criteria and clarify any concerns with the Club.
- Confirm your preference to play either 1 day or 2 day cricket. Advise the Selection committee of your availability to play both forms of the game if you wish to do so.
- Talk with your coach about any concerns and seek feedback about how to improve your performance.
- Let the Club know if you are unavailable for matches or training.
