

GOLDEN GROVE CRICKET CLUB INCORPORATED

FEES POLICY

1. Purpose

To ensure that the Golden Grove Cricket Club (GGCC) Management Committee provide clear direction and provision of information to club members in regards to member's fees.

2. Scope

This policy applies to players involved with Golden Grove Cricket Club Junior or Senior teams.

3. Fee Structure

The GGCC will employ a fee structure which complies with the Club's Constitution. An emphasis will be placed on minimising costs to members whilst ensuring that the costs of the GGCC (e.g. balls, equipment, trophies, pitch prep fees, insurances, hire fees etc...) are able to be met

The GGCC Management Committee shall advise of the upcoming season's fees at the AGM.

Levies, determined necessary by the GGCC Management Committee may be introduced from time to time and will be included within the overall fee.

4. Payment of Fees (Subscription)

The upcoming season's fee amount will be made available to GGCC members (players/guardians/life members) at the GGCC AGM.

Players Registered prior to matches commencing:

- fees should be paid in full prior to the end of October (unless a written request for paying by instalments is granted, see below for specific details)

Players who register throughout the season, as a fill in player or permanent player:

- fees will need to be paid within 14 days of playing, a minimum amount of \$50.00 will be required within this time so that the player is covered by the Club's insurance.

GGCC provides the opportunity for fees to be paid by instalments. A written request seeking approval must be provided to the Club Treasurer prior to the player participating in a match. The Club Management Committee will review each application before notifying the applicant of their decision. Where arrangements have been sought from and agreed to by the Management Committee which differs to the conditions above, payment of fees must be made as agreed.

5. Late or non-payment of fees

If, unless otherwise agreed to with the Management Committee, full payment of a players fee has not be made in accordance with the conditions above, the player will not be allowed to participate in any games until payment has been made.

No player shall be selected for a finals series unless all fees have been paid in full.

A player who has outstanding monies at the end of the season will not be awarded a trophy (or medallion for juniors) at the end of season presentation event.

A player who has outstanding monies at the end of the season will not be allowed to play in a following season until all outstanding monies have been paid in full.

The GGCC Management Committee will not grant a clearance to any player who has outstanding monies payable to GGCC until all outstanding monies have been paid in full.
