

## SENIOR PLAYER REPRESENTATIVE

## **Key duties**

- The Senior Player Representative (SPR) is a voluntary role.
- To objectively provide feedback to the Club Committee from a player's perspective.
  - This may be done in formal settings, such as a Club Committee meeting or an informal setting as appropriate.
- To attend Club Committee meetings to be able to share relevant information with the playing group and to provide feedback to the Club Committee.
  - o The SPR does not have voting rights unless the SPR is also a member of the Committee.
  - There may be times when the SPR is asked to leave the meeting so that confidential information can be discussed by the Club Committee.
- To act as the primary point of contact for players who have a grievance against a coach, captain or somebody in any other leadership position.
- To support players who may be subjected to formal and informal disciplinary proceedings.
- To be the conduit between the Club Committee and the playing group regarding important Club information. For example:
  - o The payment of membership fees.
  - Club fundraisers
  - Presentation evenings

## Required skills

- Good communication skills.
- Friendly and caring attitude.
- Is aware of the future directions and plans of Golden Grove Cricket Club (GGCC).
- Is a supportive leader for all members.
- Maintain confidentiality.
- To acknowledge the requirement for separation of personal interests and GGCC matters
- Act in the best interest of the GGCC at all times whilst in the assigned role.
